IRL Releases New Planned Parenthood **Donor List**

DES MOINES -It's accountability time. Iowa Right to Life is releasing its latest list highlighting donors to Planned Parenthood of Greater Iowa (PPGI).

PPGI education programs increase their abortion business. Last year, PPGI did 4,397 abortions. That is up from 2,898 in 2002. And now they are planning to offer walk-in abortions. (See story on Page 2)

ST. PAUL - A young, solidly pro-life governor, who has shaken up politics in Alaska has fired up Republicans for the November elections.

John McCain's choice of Sarah Palin as his vice presidential running mate has catapulted the Republicans to a 10-point lead over the Democrat ticket of Obama/Biden in a USA/ Gallup poll among likely voters nationwide, taken the weekend after the Republican National Convention.

Palin's ability to walk the talk has garnered admiration of her from both prolifers and anti-lifers. Palin made headlines back in April, when she and her husband, Todd, gave birth to a Downs Syndrome child, despite being told ahead of time that she could have aborted him. Baby Trig made an appearance with Palin's other four children, during her historic speech September 3 at the Republican National Convention in St. Paul, MN, where she promised to be an advocate in the White House for families with special needs children.

Fight Against Planned Parenthood Heats Up in Iowa

PPGI Planning Walk-In Abortions All Over Iowa

DES MOINES—Planned Parenthood of Greater Iowa (PPGI) is planning no appointment, walk-in abortions at all 27 of it's locations throughout Iowa.

lowa's largest abortion provider plans to do this by offering dangerous RU-486 chemical abortions with a Des Moines-based abortionist consulting by webcam.

Planned Parenthood does not follow the Food and Drug Administration's protocol on RU-486, instead using a cheaper combination of the pills which makes the abortions more profitable for Planned Parenthood and more dangerous for women. The women are forced to abort at home, where they will deal with the trauma, the blood and the dead baby—alone.

Currently PPGI performs 85 percent of the chemical abortions in lowa and over 56 of the surgical abortions in Iowa.

PPGI Targets Teens with Implanted Birth Control

DES MOINES—lowa Right to Life is warning about Planned Parenthood's latest ploy to target teens with dangerous inserted and implanted birth control devices.

PPGI is pushing free IUD and Implanon birth control on Face-book.com, a social networking website popular with teens and college students. Despite the fact that IUD and Implanon carry serious, long-term medical risks and the possibility of additional surgery to have them removed, PPGI's Facebook page*, is promoting the devices to young people as "Worry free and easy."

PPGI, lowa's largest abortion provider, makes no secret that the free IUDs and Implanon is designed to build business. After a similar giveaway last December, a PPGI staff member was quoted in PPGI's *Source* newsletter as saying, "One of the

goals of the promotion, in addition to preventing unwanted pregnancy, is to recruit more clients to PPGI."

Contact HHS to Protect Prolife Health Care Professionals

WASHINGTON D.C.—The public has until September 20 to contact the U.S. Department of Health and Human



Services on a proposed rule to protect doctors and other health care professionals who refuse to participate in

abortions and other procedures.

Planned Parenthood is waging a fierce email campaign against the rule, because they want to force more doctors, nurses and other health care professionals into the abortion industry—against their will.
